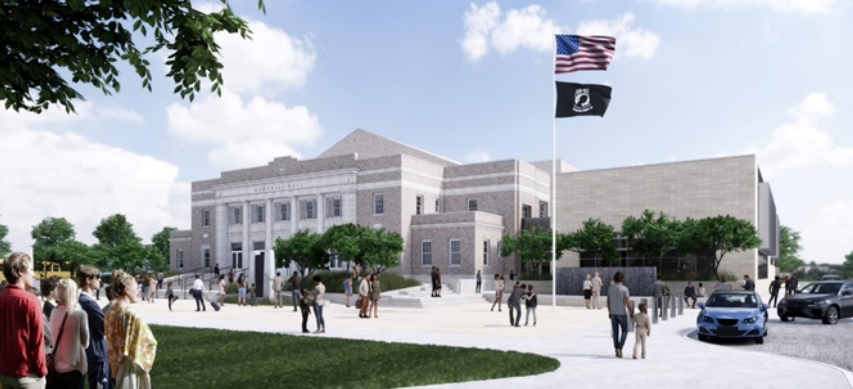

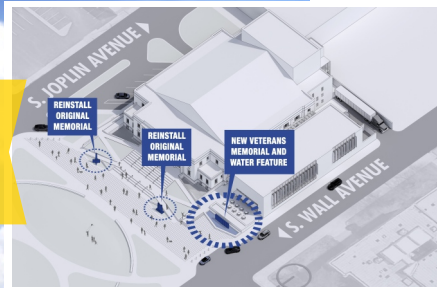

## Question 1 on the April 5, 2022 ballot asks Joplin voters:

***"Shall the City Council of the City of Joplin, Missouri be authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the amount not to exceed \$30,000,000 to reconstruct, renovate, expand, and improve Memorial Hall, and to improve related parking?"***

If voters approve the initiative, the bond debt will be paid through the assessment of real property and personal property taxes. For an average \$100,000 home in Joplin and a \$20,000 vehicle, the estimated monthly cost is \$6.20 - less than the monthly cost for your favorite streaming app or eating out for lunch.
